



Title: Community Counselor

Primary Function: This counselor will provide individual and group counseling to Safe Harbor clients. Counseling services include crisis intervention, trauma and recovery counseling, case management, legal and community advocacy, safety planning and education on the dynamics of domestic violence. The counselor will also facilitate shelter support groups and other groups as needed. This counselor will be based primarily in Greenville County but may also assist with groups and individual counseling in Anderson County or Oconee County, as needed. **This is a full time, salaried position eligible for full benefits.**

Reports to: Director of Community Counseling & Advocacy Services

Job Responsibilities:

Provide assessments, crisis intervention, trauma and recovery counseling, case management, legal and community advocacy, safety planning and education on the dynamics of Domestic Violence for clients.

Provide advocacy for clients and collaborate with other community systems in order to assist clients in navigating through barriers and obstacles.

Facilitate meaningful and appropriate psycho-educational and therapeutic group counseling sessions for clients.

Develop collaborative relationships and network with local community agencies, providing information about Safe Harbor and trainings about domestic violence.

Complete paperwork and compile monthly reports and statistics.

Participate in Safe Harbor staff meetings, team meetings, trainings and continuing education.

Enthusiastically support and model the mission and vision of Safe Harbor to peers, clients, and the community.

Perform other tasks and responsibilities as assigned by supervisor.

Qualifications:

- Master's degree completed or in progress in Psychology, Counseling, Social Work or related field. Licensure active in SC preferred.
- Ability to relate to others in an empathetic, non-judgmental, and supportive manner.
- Bilingual language skills (Spanish and English) are preferred but not required
- Possess insight and self-awareness to be confident in the role, with knowledge of personal capabilities and limitations.
- Knowledge of the dynamics of domestic violence is preferable.

- Must work well in a team setting, and be able to utilize other direct service staff to gain perspective and assistance with duties of the job.
- Possession of a valid SC Driver's License and a reliable transportation for occasional travel.
- Proficiency with Word, Excel and willingness to learn client database.
- Ability to work flexible hours including some evening hours.
