Sexual Citizens transforms how we understand and address sexual assault. *Sexual Citizens* reveals the social ecosystem that makes sexual assault a predictable element of life on a college campus. The research reshapes our understanding of sexual assault and provides a new roadmap for how to address it.

The authors of *Sexual Citizens*, Hirsch and Khan, will join us to discuss the concepts of sexual projects, sexual citizenship, and sexual geographies. They will provide a new language for understanding the forces that shape young peoples' sexual relationships and how we can address them in our communities.

Objectives:

- Identify and understand concepts of sexual projects, sexual citizenship, and sexual geographies.
- Identify tangible examples of how sexual assault is built into your campus environment through these concepts.
- Explore strategies to "redesign it" out of your own campus or communities through community and policy level change.
- Explore strategies to create equity and safety in physical spaces on campus and in communities.
