#### THE STRUCTURE

01

##### Intro Meeting

A virtual, 1 hour introductory meeting that covers key logistic information about the course.

02

##### Online Lessons

The bulk of the course consists of several online, self-paced learning modules. The lessons cover a range of topics such as ethics, victim's rights, trauma-informed care, and other state and national criteria. The lessons will take a minimum of 11 hours to complete.

03

##### Large Group

This virtual session is a live meeting with the entire cohort of new VSPs. The meeting is designed to review information from online lessons and offer new information in a group setting.
